

Tatenhill & Rangemore Parish Council Asset Register

In accordance with the Council's Financial Regulations, the Responsible Financial Officer is responsible for maintaining an Asset Register of all significant assets owned by the Council. This is to include an inventory of equipment which costs £250 or more and has a life expectancy of 5 years. The Chairman of Finance Committee will verify the Asset Register annually.

All expenditure on the acquisition, creation or enhancement of fixed assets is reported in the notes to the Council's accounts, provided that the fixed asset yields benefits to the authority and the services it provides for a period of more than one year. Fixed assets are valued on the basis recommended by CIPFA. The year end values are stated on the following basis.

Land, operational properties and other operational assets are reported in notes to the accounts at current insurance values as approximating to the lower of net current replacement cost and net realisable value.

Infrastructure assets are included at historical cost, net of depreciation.

Certain community assets are the subject of restrictive covenants as to their; use and/or future disposal. Such assets are therefore considered to have no appreciable realisable value and are included at nominal value only.

This Register is divided into 11 annexes, each setting out the values of certain classes of assets at the beginning and end of the year, and additions and deletions to that annexe during the year.




